Responsibilities

Clinical Treatment and Documentation –

- Conduct diagnostic assessments including DC:0-5 assessments
- Develop and implement treatment plans with the family based on the diagnosis
- Provide individual, dyadic, and or family therapy
- Care coordination with other professionals working with the child
- Maintain required documentation as specified by legal and ethical expectations

Supervision and Professional Development:

- Participate in weekly reflective consultation, twice monthly group reflective consultation
- Participate in Child Parent Psychotherapy training and consultation if not already rostered
- Work towards or maintain Infant Mental Health Endorsement as defined by Minnesota Association for Children’s Mental Health – Infant & Early Childhood Division
- Maintain required CEUs

Requirements or Preferences

- Must have a Master’s or Doctoral degree in Social Work, Psychology, or other human service field Independent licensure as LICSW, LPCC, LP, or LMFT preferred, if not licensed, supervision can be provided for LMFT and LPCC licensure tracks.
- Prefer experience working with young children and caregivers or a desire to learn to work with this population.
- Strong skills in children’s mental health diagnostic assessment and treatment
- Demonstrated knowledge of cultural diversity and the role of culture in the therapeutic process
